Masonry Contractors: Annual dues are determined by annual dollar volume: <\$500,000 annual volume, **\$350 (R1)**; \$500,001 - \$1,500,000 annual volume, **\$500 (R2)**; \$1,500,001 - \$3,000,000 annual volume, **\$650 (R3)**; \$3,000,001 - \$6,000,000 annual volume, **\$900 (R4)**; and \$6,000,001 > annual volume, **\$1,200 (R5)**. (Association dues are determined on the "honor system.")
Associate/Suppliers: (Includes any member company other than masonry contractor firms or general contractor firms with distinct masonry divisions.) Annual dues are determined by the number of chapters the firm participates in: For one chapter: **\$350 (A1)**, for two chapters: **\$700 (A2)**, for three chapters: **\$1,000 (A3)**, and for four or more chapters: **\$1,200 (A4)**.
"Leadership" Member: Voluntarily paying double dues (above.)
"Distinguished" Member: Voluntarily paying double dues (above) and maintaining membership in the "Mason Contractors Association of America" (MCAA).
Local Supplemental Fees: Local NCMCA chapters charge local dues which are collected by the state office and are included on annual dues renewal statements. Local fees are set locally and vary from chapter to chapter. Members are expected to pay local dues to the chapter closest to the member firm and/or to area representative's base location. (Out-of-state and extremely remote in-state members may choose to be exempt from local dues.) Local fees are charged on a company basis and are as follows: **Central Piedmont (Winston-Salem area): \$100, Eastern Chapter (Kinston, Greenville, Rocky Mount, Jacksonville area): \$50, Sandhills Chapter (Fayetteville, Southern Pines): \$100, Land of the Sky Chapter (Greater Asheville area): \$50, Metroline Chapter (Greater Charlotte area): \$125, Raleigh Chapter: \$200** (Raleigh dues include meeting meals for one representative.), **Triad Chapter (Burlington, Greensboro area): \$50**, and **Western Carolina Chapter (Hickory, Morganton, Statesville, Lenoir areas): \$100.**

Membership renewal fees are due annually in membership anniversary month. NCMCA (State) membership is required for participation in local chapters. This form may be photocopied. If there are additional representatives who should be on the NCMCA mailing list, please include names, addresses, e-mail addresses and phone numbers on the backside of this application or on a separate sheet of paper. (As a cost saving measure, please include only representatives who plan to be active in the Association.) Dues fee schedule is subject to change without notice.

Contributions, donations, and membership fees paid to the North Carolina Masonry Contractors Association are not tax deductible as charitable contributions. However, they may be tax deductible as ordinary and necessary business expense.

“How can my company join the North Carolina Masonry Contractors Association?”

First, firms, not individuals, are members of NCMCA. Any company in the masonry contracting business or that provides materials, equipment or services to the masonry industry are welcomed and encouraged to be a part of the Association. In fact, any firm that is part of the Carolina masonry industry strongly benefits from the work of NCMCA, whether a member or not. Supporting NCMCA is supporting the industry!

There are two categories of Association membership. Masonry contracting firms and general contracting firms that self-perform or subcontract masonry are **“Regular Members.” (“R”)** Firms that manufacture and supply materials, provide equipment and services are **“Associate Members.” (“A”)**

Joining NCMCA requires submitting a completed application along with a check for the first year’s dues. (VISA or MasterCard payments are also accepted. A 5% convenience fee applies.) The application is available for download online at ncmca.com, or can be requested via email. The application requests general contact and billing information and basic information about the company, including the names and contact information for representatives who will participate in Association activities. Names and contact information will be included in the Association directory, available online and distributed as a hard copy once a year.

The dues fee schedule is included on the application. Dues for Regular Members (R) are determined on the “honor system” based on gross annual sales. The number of local NCMCA chapters with which a firm is affiliated determines dues for Associate Member (A) firms. There are eight local NCMCA chapters. In-state associate member firms are expected to affiliate with at least one local chapter and encouraged to affiliate with all the local chapters where the member firm has offices or a strong local presence. However, any NCMCA member firm representative is always welcomed at any local or state NCMCA function.

In addition to NCMCA annual dues, each of the local chapters also collects an annual local fee, the amount of which is determined by the local chapter and varies from chapter to chapter. The fee schedule for the local chapters is included on the application. Local chapter fees should be included in the payment made with the application and will be itemized and included on future membership renewal notices.

Many NCMCA member firms have special designated membership status, which is available to any NCMCA member firm. **“Leadership Member”** firms voluntarily pay double their annual dues. **“Distinguished Member”** firms voluntarily pay double their annual dues plus commit to maintaining membership in the Mason Contractors Association of America (MCAA.) NCMCA does not want to discourage any firm from belonging to the Association because of the cost. Compared to similar organizations, NCMCA dues are inexpensive. However, choosing “Leadership” or “Distinguished” membership status is an opportunity for companies to express their appreciation for the full value of membership in the Association.

Annual membership renewal notices are mailed for the anniversary month of when a firm joined the association, so prorating dues payments is not necessary.
